

Terms and Conditions of Sale

1. Your Quotation is valid for 1 month from the date that it is issued. Our quotations are based on good access direct to the site and will include unobstructed access to the site and allow for unloading no more than 10m from the site. If this is not the case, the customer is responsible for any specific equipment to allow transportation to the site/additional labour or machinery costs incurred.
2. Any date for delivery given by us is given in good faith, but is an estimate only, the date may change due to staffing/access/transport or weather conditions. We will notify the customer of any delays by email. Should the delivery date be changed by the customer, we cannot be responsible for any further delays.
3. Terms of payment are as follows:
 - a. One half (50%) of the total price is required upon placing the order.
 - b. The remaining second half (50%) is due upon delivery. If this payment is not received at this point, we reserve the right to return to our base with the order. Payment should be made by Bank transfer, unless by prior agreement. We reserve the right to charge an additional 10% for any late payment. Should any further action be required to collect moneys due, any additional costs, including legal costs, shall be paid by the customer.
4. The customer is responsible for ensuring that any consents or permissions required, are obtained prior to the erection of any structure.
5. All ground works are the responsibility of the customer unless they are specifically included in the quotation. Field Shelters erected directly onto a level earth site should be fixed/pinned down by the customer. Additional fixings may be required on exposed sites and these are the responsibility of the customer. Risk in the goods shall be passed onto the customer upon delivery, CL Equestrian Ltd cannot be held responsible for damages incurred by fire, explosion, flood, lightening, an act of god, i.e. storm damage/wind damage. It is recommended that the customer ensures the product delivered is insured for such damages.
6. Any transit damage must be reported within 3 days of delivery.
7. We cannot accept responsibility for timber shrinkage, expansion, cracking, warping or the like. It is the customers responsibility to maintain their structure. All timber should be treated at least once every year. Further treatment may be required where the structure is situated in an exposed area. It is not the responsibility of CL Equestrian to return to site and adjust any movement.
